



## Review Process and Timeline

### Review Process

Community Review Panels (CRP's) composed of community volunteers with relevant experience and expertise review all of the proposals and rank them according to the current year IWF grant priorities and the procedures described in the Grant Review Process document.

The rankings are reported to the IWF Grants Committee which then evaluates the top-ranked proposals from the CRP's and makes funding recommendations to the IWF Board of Directors. The Board of Directors makes the final funding decisions.

### Timeline

February 2019: Grant application period opens

March 4, 2019: Deadline for requesting a Mentor who can review the draft of your grant application before being submitted to the IWF.

March 14, 2019: Statewide Information Session via Zoom

April 30, 2019: Grant applications due in IWF office by 5 p.m. CDT

September 2019: Applicants notified.

October 3, 2019: Successful applications featured at IWF Luncheon

January 2020: Check presentation and contracts signed

July 2020: Mid-year reports due, followed by distribution of second allocation of funds

January 2021: Final reports due
