Run Like A Mother Is Back!


Have you registered for Run Like A Mother yet? Join the University of Northern Iowa Women in Business at Big Woods Lake (South Side) in Cedar Falls on

Child Care Solutions Fund

The IWF has established the Child Care Solutions Fund (CCSF) and will be accepting Letters of Interest (LOIs) for funding consideration beginning **June 15, 2019**. This field of interest fund provides grants designated to improve the lives of Iowa's women and girls through economic self-sufficiency, specifically by improving the availability of quality, affordable, accessible child care.

The funds in the CCSF are invested in organizations and institutions focusing on innovative and sustainable strategies/solutions ensuring access and availability to affordable quality child care that decreases the work force gap and ultimately increases women's economic security across Iowa.
